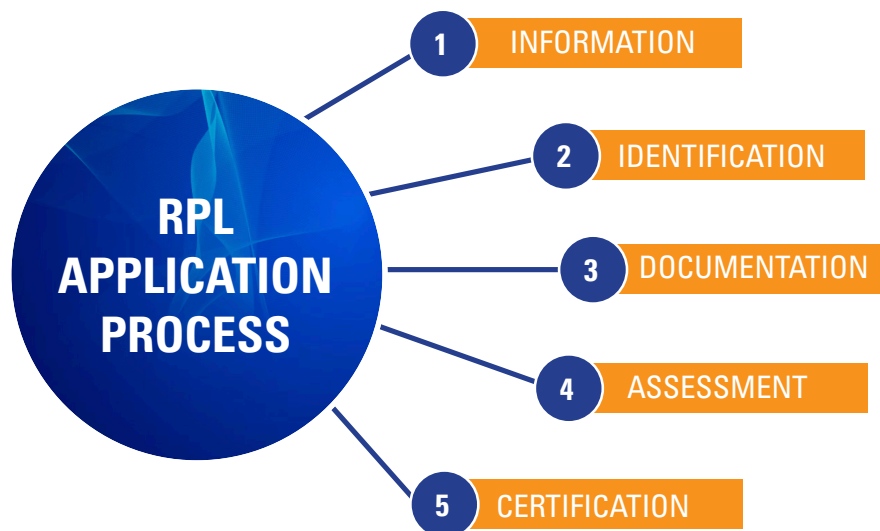


Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Process at BOU



- **Information:** Applicants find out about RPL opportunities and how the process works
- **Identification:** Applicants explore what they learnt from their experiences with a view to applying for RPL assessment. They identify and isolate what they know and can demonstrate and apply for assessment.
- **Documentation:** Applicants make reflections and gather the relevant information and package it appropriately such as in CV and job description to support their application.
- **Assessment:** The application is assessed by BQA accredited subject experts. A range of assessment methods can be used, including, but not limited to challenge exams, essays or portfolio.
- **Certification:** The successful applicant will receive formal recognition or certification
