What is RPL?

It is a process that evaluates the skills and knowledge gained through work and life experience. The outcome can help one to:

- Gain entrance into a programme that they do not have academic qualifications for
- Get assessed for a course without attending classes and get exempted from doing it if they are found competent.

Who should attend?

- **Prospective Students (RPL for Access)**
Individuals with significant work and life experience who may not have standard academic entry requirements.
- **Current BOU Students (RPL for Credit)**
Students enrolled with us who feel they already have the knowledge of the content of certain courses due to their past job experiences.
